OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors must be high school students and a resident of Missouri. An entry fee of \$5.00 per artist for two (2) pieces will apply. Make checks or money orders payable to Missouri State Fair. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**

- NEW** 2. The Missouri State Fair does not guarantee premium money, merchandise, prizes or special awards. Because the State Fair Commission is without constitutional or statutory authority to borrow money for its operation, it reserves the right to prorate premium money because of state budget restraints.
- 3. Work must be original work by the artist entering and not previously shown at the Missouri State Fair and completed during high school. Exhibitors may submit two (2) entries. Works of fine art in all media will be accepted for entry. Entry blank must be received by July 20, 2009.
- NEW** 4. Art work will be accepted Saturday, August 1, Saturday, August 8 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Sunday August 9 from 2 to 6 p.m. in the Fine Arts Building. If you cannot deliver your work at the designated times, please make arrangements to have someone else deliver your work for you. Artwork will not be accepted before August 1. Last day to deliver artwork is August 9, 6 p.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If shipping, ship prepaid to arrive by August 1, to the Fine Arts Department, Missouri State Fair, 2503 W. 16th St., Sedalia, MO 65301. If return shipment is requested, a \$25 handling fee is due upon receipt of the work. Make checks or money orders payable to the Missouri State Fair. **DO NOT SEND CASH. DO NOT USE PACKING PEANUTS.**
- NEW** 5. All paintings, graphics, photographs and drawings must be mounted on matt board. **NO POSTER BOARD WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- 6. Due to limited display space, art work may not exceed 24" in height and three (3) dimensional work may not exceed 2 square foot, unless the Superintendent has given permission. We have room for 1 or 2 larger pieces.
- 7. Artist must provide any special materials and do installation for three (3) dimensional work requiring a special presentation.
- 8. The artist's signature verifies the understanding that all work submitted is at the artist's own risk. The Missouri State Fair cannot assume responsibility for lost or damaged art work. Any insurance coverage must be provided by the artist.
- 9. The primary audience of the Missouri State Fair consists of families and youth. The Missouri State Fair reserves the right to reject any works of art that may be considered objectionable by that audience.
- 10. Do not be concerned if you do not receive your exhibitor tags before delivery date. Exhibitor tags will be available at check in. If you do receive exhibitor tags before check-in date, please attach them by the string to the lower left hand corner on the back.
- 11. Art work may be picked up Sunday, August 23, 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. or Monday, August 24, between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. at the Fine Arts Building. Last time to pickup artwork at the Fine Arts Building will be 2 p.m. Monday, August 24. If you cannot pickup your work at the designated times, please make arrangements to have someone else pickup your work for you. Work that is not picked up Sunday or Monday will be available for pick up at the Administrative Offices on Tuesday, August 25, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Any work not picked up within 10 days after the fair closes will become the property of the Missouri State Fair unless prior arrangements have been made.
- 12. Work that is for sale will be charged a 25% commission if sold during the Fair. Please price your piece accordingly. No changes are permitted as to price, item or title, after tags are received by the artist. Any change must be authorized by the Fine Arts Superintendent.
